TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER

NEW ABLUTION BLOCK, PAVILION, UPGRADING AND RENOVATIONS OF EXISTING ABLUTION AND PARKING AREA AT THE RUSTDENE SPORT COMPLEX

Bids are invited by the Municipal Manager of Beaufort West Municipality for the Construction of new ablution block, pavilion, upgrading and renovations of existing ablution and parking area at the Rustdene Sport Complex.

It is estimated that the Tenderers for the main contract should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of **5GB** or higher.

Functionality Criteria: Similar relevant experience of the Main Contractor and project experience of both Construction Manager & General Foreman are required

Only those tenderers who have in their employ management and supervisory staff satisfying the requirements of the scope of work for labour intensive competencies for supervisory and management staff are eligible to submit tenders. It is required that the Foreman/Supervisor have completed the skills programme at NQF level 4 "National Certificate: Supervision of Civil Engineering Construction Processes", and it is required that the Site Agent/ Construction Manager have completed NQF level 5 "Manage Labour-Intensive Construction Processes" or equivalent QCTO qualifications.

Stage 1: Functionality

Only Tenders scoring a minimum of **20 out of 30 for company experience and 6 out of 10 for personnel experience** will be considered further for evaluation in stage 2.

Stage 2: Price and Preference

Tenders will be evaluated and adjudicate in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act 5 of 2000) Regulations 2017 and the Beaufort West Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy, where **80** points will be scored for price and **20** points for B-BBEE status. Local content requirements is 50-100% applicable to relevant items in bid document.

A compulsory clarification meeting will be held at the Rustdene Sport Complex on Van Schalkwyk Street in Beaufort West on TUESDAY, 23 AUGUST 2022 at 10:00. No tenderers will be allowed to attend the compulsory site inspection meeting if they arrive more than 15 minutes after the meeting commenced. Documents will be available for collection at the compulsory site inspection meeting and prospective bidders must book their tender documents in advance two days before the site inspection. Formal Bids will then be opened in the presence of anyone who wishes to attend, in the Committee Room in the Supply Chain Management Office at the Shop Nr 7 Union Street Sanlam Building, Donkin Street, Beaufort West.

Telegraphic, telephonic, e-mailed and late Bids will not be accepted. The lowest, only or any Bid shall not necessarily be accepted and the Council reserves the right to accept any part of the Bid.

The Bid must be valid for a period of 120 (one hundred and twenty) days after the closing date. The Bid will be subject to Council's Supply Chain Management Policy, the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act and the Amended Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017. The 80/20 preference points system will be applicable.

It is a prerequisite that all prospective service providers who are not yet registered on the Central Supplier Database, register without delay by completing the prescribed online registration forms which are obtainable on the CSD website www.csd.gov.za. Bidders are further requested to ensure that all compliance documents are submitted with the original bid documents.
