CONTRACT FOR THE UPGRADING OF DLISO & MATSHAKA STREETS

Bids are invited by the Municipal Manager of BEAUFORT WEST MUNICIPALITY for the upgrading of Dliso & Matshaka Streets. The scope of works consists of the construction of approximately 450 m road.

It is estimated that the Tenderers for the main contract should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 3CE or higher. A prerequisite of 60% exist for functionality.

Local Beaufort West nominated sub-contract tenders (labour only) will also be invited in terms of Council's Supply Chain Management Policy.

Documents will only be available for collection at the compulsory site inspection meeting if tenderers booked their tender documents 2 days in advance before the site inspection. No tenderers will be allowed to attend the compulsory site inspection meeting after 10:10.

Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late bids will not be accepted. The lowest, only or any bid shall not necessarily be accepted and the Council reserves the right to accept any part of the bid.

The bid must be valid for a period of 90 (ninety) days after the closing date. The bid will be subject to Council's Supply Chain Management Policy, the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act and the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011.
