THREE-YEAR MAINTENANCE AND UPGRADING OF MECHANICAL AND ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS: BOREHOLES, PUMP STATIONS AND BUILDINGS

The **Beaufort West Municipality** hereby invites contractors to submit bids for the three-year maintenance and upgrading of mechanical and electrical installations: Boreholes, pump stations and buildings.

It is estimated that the contractor should have a CIDB grading designation of 4ME or higher.

A compulsory site meeting will be held at the offices of the Director: Engineering Services, 61 Bird Street, Beaufort West at Beaufort West on Tuesday, 31 March 2026 at 10:00. No tenderers will be allowed to attend the compulsory site inspection meeting if they arrive more than 15 minutes after the meeting commenced. Hard copies of the document must be booked in advance before Thursday, 26 March 2026 and will be available at the compulsory site meeting and bookings can be done with Mr. S Madumbo at sidwillm@beaufortwestmun.co.za.

A non-refundable fee of **R375.00** (Three Hundred and Seventy Five Rand), is payable for a set of printed documents. The fee must be deposited into the account of the **Beaufort West Municipality** at **NEDBANK**, Branch Code: **198765**, Account Number **107 428 0318**. The reference number for confirmation of payment is: **SCM 41/2026** and bid documents will be made available upon provision of proof of payment.

Sealed bids must be submitted in the original documents marked: **“SCM 41/2026: THREE-YEAR MAINTENANCE AND UPGRADING OF MECHANICAL AND ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS: BOREHOLES, PUMP STATIONS AND BUILDINGS”** must be addressed to the Acting Municipal Manager and placed in the tender box at the Office of the Supply Chain Management Unit in the Sanlam Building, 112 Donkin Street, Beaufort West, before the closing time and date of **14:00 on FRIDAY, 24 April 2026**. Tender documents will then be opened in the presence of anyone who wishes to attend, in the Committee Room in the Supply Chain Management Office at the Sanlam Building, Donkin Street, Beaufort West.

The evaluation of this bid will be subjected to functionality scoring. Bidders must achieve a minimum functionality score of **80 out of 100** points for functionality in order to be evaluated further. The functionality criteria and weighting are set out in the tender document.

Pre-evaluation criteria and weight:

1. Company (or JV) General Experience carrying a weight of 30 points
2. Company (or JV) Specific Experience carrying a weight of 55 points
3. Key Staff and Personnel carrying a weight of 15 points

Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late tenders will not be accepted. The lowest, only or any tender shall not necessarily be accepted and the Council reserves the right to accept any part of the tender. The tender must be valid for a period of 90 (ninety) days after the closing date.

The bid will be subject to Council's Supply Chain Management and Preferential Procurement Policies. The 80/20 preference points system will be applicable. A maximum of 80 points will be awarded for Price and a maximum of 20 points will be awarded for the following Specific Goals:
